A49 Onibury to Woofferton Renewals of Road Markings and Road Studs**

I wish to inform you that Kier will be carrying out a road renewal scheme on the A49 northbound and southbound between Onibury and Woofferton in Shropshire on behalf of Highways England.

For your information, the details of the project are summarised below:

Planned Start Date: 31 October 2016
Planned Completion Date: 11 November 2016
Hours of work: 21:00 to 06:00

These dates are subject to change and are dependent on weather conditions. However, we can assure you that you will be kept fully informed of any amendments to the works schedule.

Access to businesses and residential properties will be maintained at all times.

Traffic Restrictions

Traffic management will be in the form of total overnight closures on the mainline of the A49 and any relevant side road/s, from Onibury to Woofferton.

When total overnight closures are in place, a diversion route will be in place and clearly signed. The A49 and any relevant side roads will remain fully open to traffic during the day time as normal.

Diversion Route

Diversion Route Craven Arms to Rocks Green Roundabout B4368 & B4364

Take Market St and Newton St to Corvedale Rd/B4368, Head south on Market St towards Dale St, Turn left onto School Rd, School Rd turns left and becomes Newton St, Continue on B4368 to your destination in Ludlow, Turn right onto Corvedale Rd/B4368, Continue to follow B4368, Turn right, Turn right, Continue onto Derrington Rd, Continue onto South Rd, Continue onto Oakwood Rd,

Turn right onto B4364, Turn right onto Rocks Green/A4117, Enter the roundabout. Diversion Ends.

Diversion Route Rocks Green to Woofferton A4117 & A456


Head north-east on Rocks Green/A4117 towards Duncow Rd, Continue to follow A4117, Turn right onto A456, Turn left onto A49 Woofferton. Diversion Ends.
